

Giovanni Gorno Tempini (Brescia, 1962)

A graduate of Economics and Business from Bocconi University of Milan, from 2004 to 2010 he was a visiting Professor at LIUC University in Castellanza (VA). He is currently a Professor at the MBA Program of the SDA Bocconi School of Management and a visiting Professor of Finance at Bocconi University of Milan and Ca' Foscari University of Venice. Since 2014, he has been a member of the Scientific Committee of the Ca' Foscari International College. He started his professional career at JP Morgan in 1987, holding various management posts in Milan and London. From 2001 to 2007, he worked at the Intesa Sanpaolo Group, first as CEO and Investment Banking Manager at Banca Caboto and, subsequently, as the Group's Finance and Treasury Manager. He served as General Manager and a Director of the Mittel Group from 2007 to 2010. In the same period, he was Deputy Chairman of Sorin, Chairman of Hopa and a member of the Management Board of A2A. Subsequently, he became Chairman of Fondo Strategico Italiano (2011-2015) and a Director of Borsa Italiana (2001-2007), MTS (2001-2006), EuroMTS (2002-2006), and ISDA (2006-2007). He was CEO of Cassa Depositi e Prestiti from May 2010 to July 2015 and Chairman of Fondazione Fiera Milano from September 2016 to August 2019.

He is currently a Board Director of Avio, Willis Towers Watson, FIRC, AIRC, and Luiss University. He is also a member of the Council of Assonime (Italian Association of Joint Stock Companies) and the General Council of AIFI (Italian Private Equity and Venture Capital Association). He has been non-executive Chairman of F.I.L.A. - Fabbrica Italiana Lapis ed Affini since August 2019.

He has been a Board Director of Intesa Sanpaolo since 2016.
