She graduated in Economics and Banking at Università Cattolica of Milan, where she was a research fellow until 1998. She is currently a Full Professor of Economics of Financial Intermediaries at the University of Insubria, where she was also Dean of the Department of Economics. She is Deputy Director of Centro di Ricerca sull'Etica degli Affari e sulla Responsabilità Sociale di Impresa (CreaRes) and Director of Centro per l'Internazionalizzazione delle Economie Locali (CRIEL). Over the years, she has held various professional positions as a Board Director of financial companies and institutions. She has been a member of the supervisory committee, appointed by the Bank of Italy, in several special administration and compulsory liquidation procedures for asset management companies and banks. She was a member of the Supervisory Board of Intesa Sanpaolo in the three-year period 2013-2016; she has been a Board Director of the Bank since 2016.

She is currently Chairperson of the Board of Directors of BF, a listed company, a Board Director of Società per la Bonifica dei Terreni Ferraresi e per Imprese Agricole, and a member of the Supervisory Committee of Darma Asset Management SGR in administrative compulsory liquidation. She is the author of papers and studies on various subjects, including the management and regulation of banks and insurance companies. She has been President of the Association of Lecturers of Economics of Financial Intermediaries and Financial Markets (ADEIMF) and is currently a member of the Scientific Committee of the journal Banca Impresa Società.
