

Corrado Gatti (Rome, 1974)

After graduating in Economics and Business from La Sapienza University of Rome, he received a PhD in Business Economics and Governance from the University of Naples "Parthenope" and in 2003 he was a visiting scholar at the Stern School of Business of New York University. From 2002 to 2004, he was a Researcher in Economics and Business Management at the Department of Economics of the Tor Vergata University of Rome. He then went on to become an Associate Professor in 2005 and Full Professor in 2011 in that subject area at La Sapienza University of Rome. Since 2003, Mr. Gatti has been a member of the Association of Chartered Accountants and Accounting Experts of Rome, enrolled in the Register of Independent Auditors and has provided advisory services in relation to strategic, organisational and financial matters for public and private companies, particularly regarding the corporate and financial aspects of ordinary and extraordinary transactions, company valuations, business and restructuring plans, accounting opinions, and internal control systems. In the 2004-2008 period, he was a lecturer and a consultant in organisation and management at the College of Italian National Police Force.

He is a member of the board of directors and the board of statutory auditors of various companies and entities and acts as a technical expert in civil and criminal proceedings.

He is currently Chairman of the Board of Statutory Auditors of listed company Atlantia, Chairman of the Board of Auditors of Humanitas University and a member of the Board of Auditors of the Italian Football Federation.
