- Cleanest Cloud in the Industry:
 - In 2017, we became the first major company to match 100% of our annual electricity use with renewable energy, which we've achieved every year since – this establishes Google Cloud as the "cleanest cloud in the industry."
- 24/7 Carbon Free Energy
 - We aim to run our data centers and campuses worldwide on 24/7 carbon-free energy by 2030.
 - Our progress: In 2021, we matched 66% of our data center electricity use with regional carbon-free sources, on an hourly basis.
- On average, a Google data center is twice as energy efficient as a typical enterprise data center.

Google Cloud Cybersecurity (as of 9/13/22)

- >6M websites are protected from fraud and bots by reCAPTCHA
- >40,000 vulnerabilities have been found by Google in Open Source Software Projects
- Google Cloud Armor mitigated the largest reported DDoS attack @ 46M requests per second

Google Workspace

- Google Workspace has more than 9M paying customers (3/15/23)
- There are more than 5,200 public apps in the Google Workspace Marketplace (>5B apps installed)
- Google Workspace is the world's most popular productivity tool with more than 3 billion monthly active users across the globe.

- We achieved 3x expansion of sales organization from 2019 to 2021
