

Intesa Sanpaolo – the only Italian company in the list of the 100 most sustainable corporations drawn up by Corporate Knights and presented at Davos

Intesa Sanpaolo was the only Italian company to be included in the list of the 100 most sustainable companies at world level drawn up by Corporate Knights, the Canadian magazine that specialises in sustainable capitalism.

The list was presented at Davos during the World Economic Forum and is the result of research that examined 3000 worldwide companies. This research was based on eleven indicators that concern the environment, human resources, remuneration policy, management commitment to sustainability, innovation and transparency. This recognition is even more important when considering that only 7 banks were included in the final list of 100, due to the fact that last year's financial crisis was somewhat damaging to the credibility of this sector.
