Intesa Sanpaolo won for the third year running the Green Globe Banking Award, the Italian prize for banks which support the environment

On June 15 2010 the annual Green Globe Banking Conference "Banche, Società e Mercato: il Green Banking come motore della ripresa" (Banks, Society and Market: Green banking as the engine for economic recovery) was held.

The assignation of the Green Globe Banking Award took place during this event. Intesa Sanpaolo, that won first prize in 2008 and second prize in 2009, was awarded the First Special Prize for Direct Impacts for the project "Gestione integrata degli impatti diretti dell'attività bancaria in filiali e palazzi di Intesa Sanpaolo" (Integrated management of direct impacts of banking activity in branches and buildings of Intesa Sanpaolo).
