The ranking, which aims to distinguish the large companies who have developed the best strategies to manage today's risks and opportunities in the environmental, social and governance issues, was presented at the World Economic Forum in Davos and confirmed for the third year running the presence of Intesa Sanpaolo. This recognition is even more important when considering that Intesa Sanpaolo is the only Italian company in the ranking and only 6 banks were included.
